**ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS: Must be a full-time student.**

**PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP:**

3.5-4.0 GPA or 27 ACT or GED Standard Score of 640 – Tuition up to 18 credit hours and book loan. Must be enrolled in at least 15 hours. (International students can only receive up to the out-of-state tuition rate.)

**DEAN'S SCHOLARSHIP:**

3.0-3.49 GPA or 23-26 ACT or GED Standard Score of 580 – Up to \$1000 annually (\$500 per semester) toward tuition and books. Must be enrolled in at least 15 hours.

**ACADEMIC ATHLETE:**

Awarded to students on a full athletic scholarship with a cumulative 3.5 GPA - \$1,000 annually (\$500 per semester)

**PRESIDENT'S GED AWARD:**

GED Standard Score of 640- Tuition up to 18 credit hours and book loan. Must be enrolled in at least 15 hours.

**DEAN'S GED AWARD:**

GED Standard Score of 580 – Tuition up to 18 credit hours. Must be enrolled in at least 15 hours.

**Note:** Academic scholarships are offered through the division and awarded through the Financial Aid. These scholarships are awarded based on the applicants academic and leadership abilities, ACT scores and grade point average. Applicants who wish to apply for an academic scholarship must submit this scholarship application. If you are a high school senior, a tentative award will be made based on your 7 semester transcript. Actual award will be determined upon receipt of official high school transcript.

**ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS:**

Athletic Scholarships are Books and Tuition, up to 18 hours

**CO-CURRICULAR SCHOLARSHIPS:**

Co-Curricular Scholarships are Books and Tuition, up to 18 hours.

All scholarships may only be used toward the cost of tuition, or books, or ICC room and/or board. Kansas law requires an official transcript be sent from each institution you have attended. It is your responsibility to make sure that each transcript is sent to ICC. All records submitted to the college become the property of ICC and will not be returned to the student. Any change of address or name must be filed with the Registrar's Office immediately.
