___ 2007 signed Federal 1040 tax forms and W-2's for Student

___ 2007 signed Federal 1040 tax forms and W-2's for Parents (for Dependent Students only)
(See Note 2: Who is considered a parent on the FAFSA)

___ 2007 Documentation of all other "un-taxed" income for both student and parents:
(example: Child support, Social Security, Disability, Combat pay)

___ 2007 Documentation of child support received or paid out

___ Final transcript from high school or GED **and** any previously attended colleges

___ **Optional**...If you plan to work while attending ICC, please include a copy of your:
social security card **or** birth certificate **and** your drivers license

Submission of the FAFSA is not required if:

- * you are certain that you will NOT qualify for a Pell Grant (or other federal grant programs)
- * you will NOT be applying for campus employment
- * you will NOT be applying for a student loan and your parent will NOT be applying for a Parent PLUS loan

Note 1: Am I considered Dependent or Independent on the FAFSA?

- * Were you born before January 1, 1985?
- * At the beginning of the 2008-2009 school year, will you be working on a master's or doctorate program?
- * As of today, are you married? (Answer "Yes" if you are separated but not divorced.)
- * Do you have children who receive **more than half** of their support from you?
- * Do you have dependents (other than your children or spouse) who live with you and who receive **more than half** of their support from you, now and through June 30, 2009?
- * Are (a) both of your parents deceased, or (b) are you (or were you until age 18) a ward/dependent of the court?
- * Are you currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces for purposes other than training?
- * Are you a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces?

If you (the student) answered "No" to every question above, you are considered "Dependent".

If you (the student) answered "Yes" to any question above, you are considered "Independent".

Note 2: For Dependent students: Who is considered a parent on the FAFSA?

- * Grandparents, foster parents and legal guardians are not considered parents unless they have legally adopted you.
- * If your parents are living and married to each other, answer the questions about them.
- * If your parent is widowed or single, answer the questions about that parent. If your widowed parent is remarried as of today, answer the questions about that parent and the person whom your parent married (your stepparent).
- * If your parents are divorced or separated, answer the questions about the parent you lived with more during the past 12 months. (If you did not live with one parent more than the other, give answers about the parent who provided more financial support during the past 12 months, or during the most recent year that you actually received support from a parent.) If this parent is remarried as of today, answer the questions about that parent and the person whom your parent married (your stepparent).
