**Dr. Fay Bradley**



Fay Bradley graduated from Independence High School and began his college education at Independence Community College graduating in 1958. From 1958 to 1975, Bradley continued his studies obtaining a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Pittsburg State University, Graduate Studies in Education from Wichita State University, a Juris Doctorate from Howard University Law School, and a Medical Doctorate from Howard University Medical School. Before he became a primary care physician, Bradley had served as a lab technician in the U.S. Army and had even taught junior high school science for a year. After more than 20 years of practicing governmental medicine, Dr. Bradley retired from the United States Public Health Service. His commitment to higher learning is apparent not only through his education, but also through his efforts in establishing the Irene and Henry Bradley Memorial Scholarship at ICC.
