- You and your spouses' (if married) children if you will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026. *(Student should not include any unborn children in the family size)*
- Other people if they now live with you and you or your spouse (if married) will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

Step 2. Indicate the age of each family member living in your household.

Step 3. Indicate the relationship of each family member to the student i.e. father, brother, etc.

Step 4. Include the name of the college for each household member that will be attending a post-secondary institution between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026. To be counted as attending college the individual must be enrolled at least half time in a degree, diploma or certificate program at an eligible institution.
